Reflection + Discussion Questions

Section 1: What is God's Purpose for your work?

Take a few minutes to reflect personally or discuss as a group before watching the video. The goal isn't to get perfect answers—it's to begin opening the conversation between you and God about your work.

Reflect and Discuss:

When you think about your business or work, what do you want it to be about?

What's the real reason you get up and keep going? What feels like the deeper purpose underneath the work?

Have you ever prayed about the purpose of your work?

- If so, what did that time look like?
- If not, why do you think that's been the case?

What would it look like to invite God into the question: "Why did You give me this business?"

No pressure to answer yet—just consider what it might change if you started praying that way.

Optional deeper reflection:

What's one false idea or cultural belief about success that you've had to (or need to) unlearn?

3. What’s one area where your business might already be serving a Kingdom purpose—and one area where you feel invited to grow?

Allow others to speak encouragement and challenge into this.

4. Try to begin putting language to your redemptive purpose.
