Acting On Your Value Statements

Think about Your Personal Values

- They are the cornerstone of everything you do, think, believe, and accomplish.
- Your values determine where you employ your skills and the skills of your team.

Establishing Core Values

- Your core values provide a clear, shared understanding of your organization's collective direction and lets employees know how they can contribute
 - *Reward* company values when you see them in action
