CONTENT

Iron Forums has many entrepreneurs and business leaders who are guys that dream dreams and have vision. The question is – **Are those dreams from the Lord or from man?**

Randy Pope says, *“Dreams are seeing what God has in store and seeking to see that fulfilled. Kingdom leaders think of themselves as leading a business or making money.”* Is that the biggest dream you have?

Randy encourages us to have a dream mindset. What is that?
It begins with thinking (perspective from God’s viewpoint) and hearing from God.

God speaks to His people through His word, prayer, other people, and dreams.
How do you hear from God?



John Haggai: *"It does not matter what you do. Only one thing that matters is: whatever you do for God is so great that it is doomed to failure unless God is in it."*

What is that for you?

Plan a dream-encounter with God for Him to reveal that.

Take a pad of paper for an extended period of time.

Ask God to speak and then listen with expectation that He is going to speak to you.

Write down your thoughts and ask God for confirmation that they are from Him.

If they are from God – ask him that they become a conviction (they will burn in your heart).

In other words, what is the thing that would cause you to say, "I could not do anything else."

Wonder with God what that might be. **Write it down.**

Dream in the sight and presence of God, inviting Him to stir your heart, and be obedient to do what God has said to do. Once you have that, then go and do it. Are you honored, or is God honored in what you are doing?

Be still and allow the Holy Spirit to speak and move you.

God made you for a purpose and that purpose is what puts everything in motion.
