## CHALLENGE

Start with little steps. Randy suggests two simple prayers based on John Haggai's advice:

Prayer 1. Insert "IN MY LIFE"

"Attempt something that is so great **in my life** that it is doomed to failure unless God be in it"  
God work in me. Change me. Don't look at circumstances. See what God does.

Prayer 2. Insert "THROUGH MY LIFE"

"Attempt something that is so great **through my life** that it is doomed to failure unless God be in it."  
God use me.

These prayers lead us to humility and an amazing walk of faith.
